

# **SPRING 2023 IWL FACULTY FELLOWS APPLICATION**

## APPLICATIONS DUE: NOVEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup>, 2022

The Institute for Women's Leadership is excited to announce its search for the next two Faculty Fellows for Spring 2023. We are looking for Fellows to advance gender-related research in a supportive environment for the Institute for Women's Leadership and share their research with a wide audience.

Faculty Fellows will receive a \$5,000 stipend to conduct their research over the course of Spring 2023. This stipend may be able to go toward a course buyout if approved by the person's department chair, dean, and Vice Provost for Research and Innovation.

### **Faculty Fellow Responsibilities**

- Conduct gender-related research on a project commensurate with the Faculty Fellow's background, training, discipline, and interests
- Attend weekly or biweekly check-in meetings with IWL leadership and the other Faculty Fellow
- Write a white paper for a non-academic audience to summarize and advance the gender-related research project
- Initiate a panel, symposium, workshop, or other cross-disciplinary or external-facing event for Summer or Fall 2023
- The time commitment is approximately 5 hours per week.

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

- Holds a continuing faculty or staff appointment at Marquette University
- Exhibits a proven balance of collaborative and autonomous teamwork
- Candidate preference will be given towards diversifying the IWL team in both expertise and experience.
- Consistent availability throughout the Spring 2023 semester
- No overlap of funding for the same project—the project must be original to and for IWL.
